



# Mackay Northern Beaches State High School Scholarships 2020 – Application Form

Mackay Northern Beaches State High School is committed to providing increased opportunities for students to develop their talents and represent the school in their chosen field. In recognition of the achievements of exceptional students the school has much pleasure in offering a range of scholarships for students both from within or from outside the catchment area for 2020.

Scholarships will be offered to seven students in Year 7 and four students from each of the other year levels. There will be one scholarship in each of the following categories, with the additional scholarships awarded, according to the strengths of the applicants.

- Academic
- Cultural
- Sport

The scholarships are to the value of \$350 and will be used to pay for the student's education at Mackay Northern Beaches State High School. E.g. Instrumental music fees, academic competitions and representative sports fees.

Scholarships are offered annually and students who have been successful previously may re-apply. Scholarship recipients are expected to be role models for the school, and participate fully in the extra-curricular programs at the school. Existing students, applying for any scholarship, must have **all** current resource fees paid in full. Our scholarships are generously provided by several sponsors, including Plantation Palms, Linked Group Services, Queensland Training & Development, BFX Furniture and Mackay GP Super Clinic.

Scholarships may be withdrawn if any of the above expectations are not met. If such circumstances should arise parents/caregivers will be notified in writing and given an opportunity to show cause prior to a final decision being made.

A merit based process will be used to determine scholarship recipients –

- *A written application*
- *PAT testing, if required (Academic)*
- *Demonstrated high level of academic achievement (Academic)*
- *A folio of work / performances (Cultural)*
- *A folio of Certificates and Awards supporting achievements (Sports)*
- *Demonstrated involvement in wider academic and extra-curricular school activities e.g. Internal or external representation in competitions eg. Debating, sports, band, etc.*
- *A high standard of effort and behaviour in previous school reports*
- *An interview (if required)*

Applications are due to the Year 6-7 Transition Officer by September 13 (email below) and recipients will be announced early in Term 4. There may be further information collected during the selection process. Parents and students will be invited to our 'Night of Stars' awards night at the end of the year where the scholarship will be officially presented.
