



## How to Access & Use Education Perfect

- 1. Open the web browser on your device or download the app onto your mobile device from the App Store or Google Play**

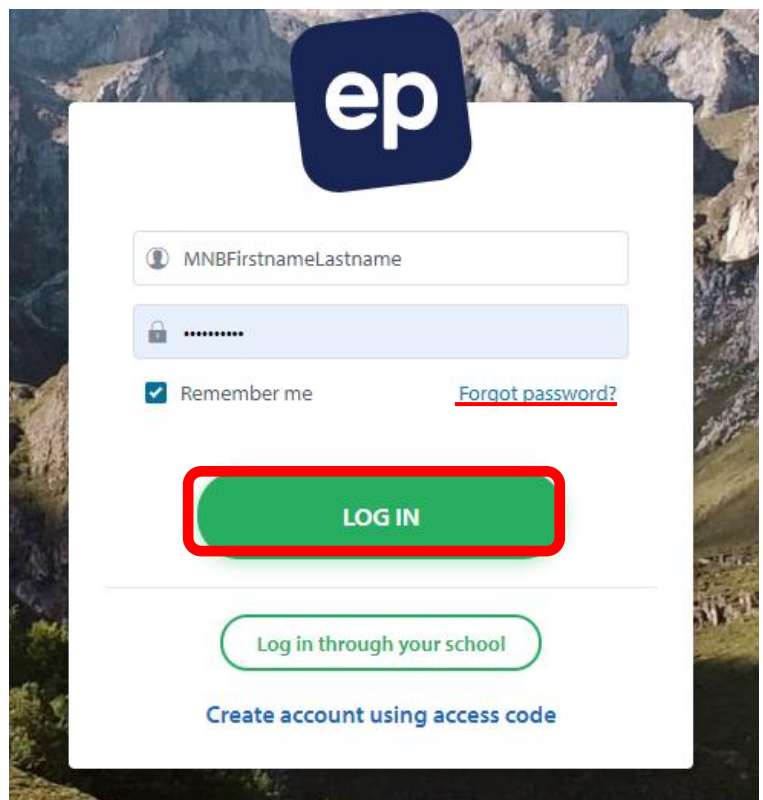
- 3. Students will need to enter their username and password. Their unique username is MNBFirstnameLastname – all one word no hyphens and using the prefer name you have provided to the school. The default password will be their first name and students can choose to change it.**

e.g. John Smith-Jones


Username: MNBJohnSmithJones

Password: John

If a student has forgotten their password they can select the "Forgot password?" option and follow the prompts by entering in their email address an email will be sent to their account.

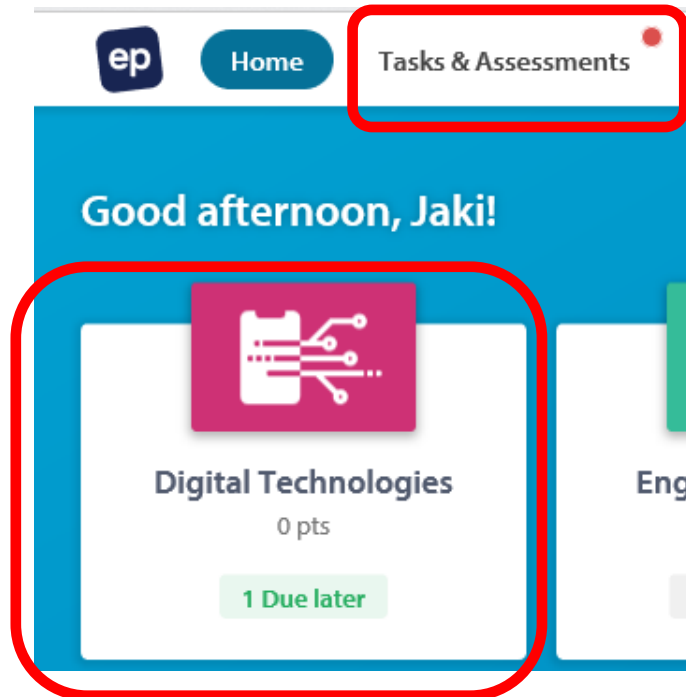


## 4. On the home screen students have a number of options.

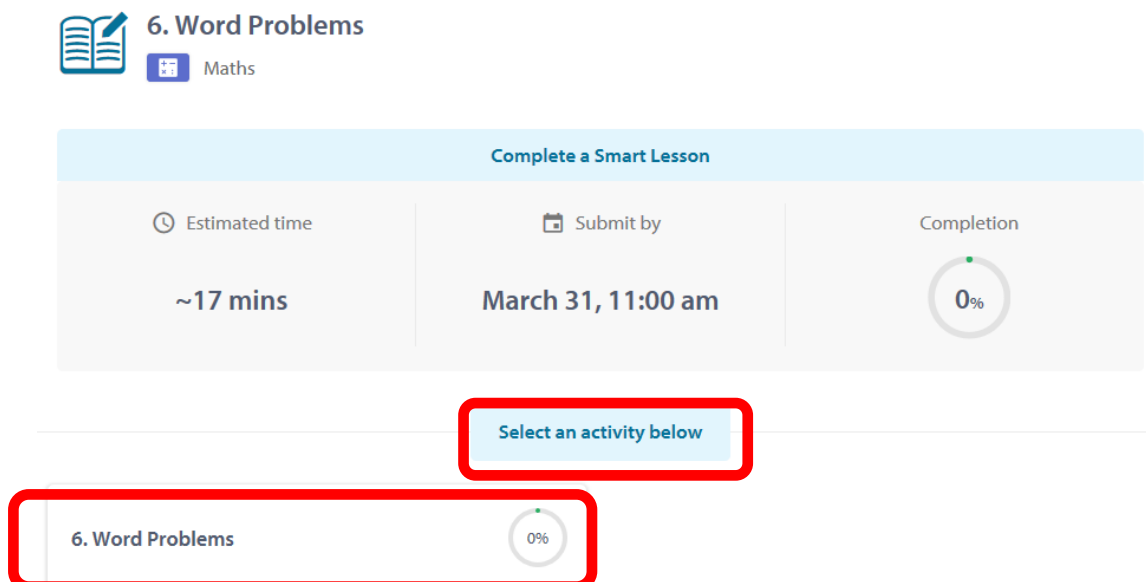


1. Students can select the subject tile and either complete the set work set by their teacher or they could browse all the content in that library
2. Students can add and remove more subject tiles
3. Students can go into their account setting and change their password, background and avatar
4. Select the Task & Assessment tab to see what work they need to complete  
\*the red dot indicates outstanding work to be completed.
5. Students can resume any tasks that have already started


**5. Completing tasks on Education Perfect. Students can either select the subject tile or the Tasks & Assessment tab.**

**7. Students will get to see the different aspects of the lesson. When ready they select start.**




